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SYNOPSIS

Requires Commissioner of Human Services to streamline SNAP application process for senior citizens and conduct outreach regarding senior SNAP participation.

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AN ACT concerning the participation of senior citizens in the New 1 2 Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program and Jersey 3 supplementing Title 44 of the Revised Statutes. 4 5 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State 6 of New Jersey: 7 8 1. a. The Commissioner of Human Services, to the maximum 9 extent permissible under federal law, shall review and streamline 10 the SNAP application process for senior citizens, as provided in this section. The goal of the streamlining process shall be to ensure that 11 12 the number of senior SNAP participants either matches or exceeds 13 ¹[the national average] <u>New Jersey's overall SNAP participation</u> rates¹. 14 b. In streamlining the SNAP application process for seniors, as 15 16 required by this section, the commissioner shall, at a minimum: 17 (1) develop and make available a simplified SNAP application 18 form for use by seniors; 19 (2) provide for the increased sharing of data between the State's various social services programs and platforms; and 20 21 (3) authorize, and establish appropriate procedures to facilitate, 22 the simultaneous or cross enrollment of eligible seniors in the 23 Medicaid program and SNAP. 24 The Department of Human Services, working in consultation c. 25 and cooperation with relevant senior citizen advocacy organizations, shall engage in comprehensive outreach efforts to 26 27 ensure that all eligible seniors are made aware of their ability to apply for and obtain SNAP benefits through a streamlined and 28 29 expedited process. At a minimum, the department shall provide 30 outreach at all health care facilities, social service agencies that 31 serve seniors in the State, and other organizations focused on food 32 assistance, and shall use all available media, including print, radio, television, and the Internet, to inform residents on the availability of 33 34 the streamlined SNAP application process established pursuant to 35 this section. d. The Commissioner of Human Services shall apply to the 36 Food and Nutrition Service within the United States Department of 37 38 Agriculture for any necessary waivers or approvals to implement 39 the provisions of this section. 40 e. As used in this section: "Commissioner" means the Commissioner of Human Services. 41 "Department" means the Department of Human Services" 42 "Medicaid program" means the State Medicaid program, 43 44 established pursuant to P.L.1968, c.413 (C.30:4D-1 et seq.).

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1 "Senior citizen" or "senior" means a person who is 60 years of 2 age or older. "SNAP" means the New Jersey Supplemental Nutrition 3 Assistance Program, established pursuant to the federal "Food and 4 5 Nutrition Act of 2008," Pub.L.110-246 (7 U.S.C. s.2011 et seq.). 6 7 2. The Commissioner of Human Services shall adopt rules and regulations, pursuant to the "Administrative Procedure Act," 8 P.L.1968, c.410 (C.52:14B-1 et seq.), as may be necessary to 9 implement the provisions of this act. 10 11 12 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
