The Commissioner of Environmental Protection shall 9 designate in, and include the designation in the master plan and 10 management plan for, each State park and forest at least one native 11 bee nesting habitat area of the State park in which loose, 12 undisturbed soil and undisturbed foliage and vegetation shall be 13 maintained, as appropriate, to provide native bee habitat for native 14 The commissioner shall consult with bees to build nests. 15 entomologists, knowledgeable nonprofits or organizations, and any 16 appropriate experts to ensure the proper location, other 17 establishment, and maintenance of each native bee nesting habitat 18 area, with minimal threat from fire, danger to the public, or impact on the public's use and enjoyment of the State park or forest. 19 20 b. The Division of Parks and Forestry in the Department of 21 Environmental Protection shall post signs, as appropriate, notifying 22 the public of the perimeters of each designated native bee nesting 23 habitat area and its purpose, and take any other cautionary measures 24 necessary to avoid destruction of the native bee nesting habitat area 25 and injurious interactions between the native bees and the public in 26 and around each designated native bee nesting habitat area. 27 The Commissioner of Environmental Protection shall adopt, c. pursuant to the "Administrative Procedure Act," P.L.1968, c.410 28 29 (C.52:14B-1 et seq.), such rules and regulations as may be 30 necessary concerning the designation, location, establishment, and 31 maintenance of native bee nesting habitat areas pursuant to this 32 section. 33 34 2. This act shall take effect immediately. 35 36 37 **STATEMENT** 38

39 The bill directs the Commissioner of Environmental Protection 40 to designate at least one native bee nesting habitat area in each of 41 the State parks and forests. The bill specifies that each designated 42 native bee nesting habitat area would have loose, undisturbed soil 43 and undisturbed foliage and vegetation which would be maintained 44 to provide native bee habitat for native bees to build nests. The bill 45 also directs the commissioner to consult with entomologists, 46 knowledgeable nonprofits or organizations, and any other

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appropriate experts to ensure the proper location, establishment, and
maintenance of each native bee nesting habitat area, with minimal
threat of fire, danger to the public, or impact on the public's use and
enjoyment of the State park or forest. The bill further requires the
Division of Parks and Forestry in the Department of Environmental
Protection to:
1) post signs as appropriate notifying the public of the

1) post signs as appropriate notifying the public of the
perimeters of each designated native bee nesting habitat area and its
purpose; and

10 2) take any other cautionary measures necessary to avoid 11 destruction of the native bee nesting habitat area and injurious 12 interactions between the native bees and the public in and around 13 the designated native bee nesting habitat area.
