4 **BE IT ENACTED** *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*

7 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any other law, rule, or
8 regulation, lawful presence in the United States shall not be
9 required to obtain a professional or occupational license, provided
10 that the applicant meets all other requirements for licensure.
