This act shall take effect immediately. 21 22 23 **STATEMENT** 24 25 This bill permits health care professionals, health care facilities, 26 and insureds to file claims for treatment provided between January 1, 2020 and the end of the Public Health Emergency and State of 27 28 Emergency declared by the Governor in Executive Order 103, 29 March 9, 2020, within 365 days of the last date of service for health

30 care services provided during the covered period.
