Permits special education students and bilingual education students to repeat prior year grade level during 2020-2021 school year upon parental request.

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AN ACT concerning the voluntary grade retention of certain

2 students during the 2020-2021 school year. 3 4 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State 5 of New Jersey: 6 7 1. a. Notwithstanding the provisions of any other law to the 8 contrary, during the 2020-2021 school year, a special education 9 student or bilingual education student shall be permitted to repeat 10 the same grade level in which the student was enrolled during the 11 2019-2020 school year, provided that the parent, guardian, or other 12 person having legal custody of the student submits a written request 13 of grade retention, in accordance with subsection b. of this section, 14 before September 1, 2020.

b. (1) The parent, guardian, or other person having legal
custody of a special education student or bilingual education
student shall submit the written request of grade retention to the
superintendent of the school district of residence.

19 (2) When the parent, guardian, or other person having legal 20 custody of a special education student or bilingual education student submits a written request of grade retention to the 21 22 superintendent of the school district of residence, and the student 23 will attend a school outside of the school district of residence 24 during the 2020-2021 school year, the superintendent of the school 25 district of residence shall transmit the written request, as soon as 26 practicable, to the superintendent or other chief administrative 27 officer of the school of attendance.

c. Nothing in this section shall be construed to limit the rights 28 29 afforded to a special education student under the federal 30 "Individuals with Disabilities Education Act" right 31 (20 U.S.C. s.1400 et seq.), including the student's to 32 compensatory education when such relief shall be granted.

33 d. As used in this section:

34 "Bilingual education student" means a student who is enrolled in
35 a program of bilingual education or an English as a Second
36 Language program approved by the State Board of Education.

37 "School of attendance" means a public school or approved
38 private school for students with disabilities which a special
39 education student or bilingual education student attends.

40 "Special education student" means a student who receives
41 programs and services pursuant to chapter 46 of Title 18A of the
42 New Jersey Statutes.

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44 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

STATEMENT

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3 This bill provides that during the 2020-2021 school, special 4 ieducation and bilingual education students may repeat the grade 5 level in which the student was enrolled during the 2019-2020 school year, provided that the parent, guardian, or other person having 6 7 legal custody of the student submits a written request before 8 September 1, 2020.

9 Under the bill, the parent, guardian, or other person having legal 10 guardian of a special education student or bilingual education 11 student would be required to submit the written request to the 12 superintendent of the student's school district of residence. When the parent, guardian, or other person having legal custody of a 13 14 special education or bilingual education student submits the written 15 request to the superintendent of the school district of residence, and 16 the student will attend a school outside of the school district of 17 residence during the 2020-2021 school year, the bill requires the superintendent to transmit the written request, as soon as 18 19 practicable, to the superintendent or other chief administrative 20 officer of the student's school of attendance.
