## A4454 MURPHY, REYNOLDS-JACKSON

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1 AN ACT concerning diversity and inclusion instruction in school 2 districts and supplementing chapter 35 of Title 18A of the New 3 Jersey Statutes. 4 5 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State 6 of New Jersey: 7 8 1. a. Beginning in the 2021-2022 school year, each school 9 district shall incorporate instruction on diversity and inclusion into 10 the curriculum for students in grades 9 through 12 as part of the 11 district's implementation of the New Jersey Student Learning 12 Standards in Comprehensive Health and Physical Education. 13 b. The instruction shall: 14 (1) highlight and promote diversity, equity, inclusion, tolerance 15 and belonging on topics including: gender and sexual orientation; 16 race and ethnicity; disabilities; religious tolerance; and unconscious 17 bias; and (2) encourage safe, welcoming, and inclusive environments for 18 all students regardless of race or ethnicity, sexual and gender 19 20 identities, mental and physical disabilities, and religious beliefs. c. The Commissioner of Education shall provide school 21 districts with sample learning activities and resources designed to 22 promote diversity and inclusion. 23 24 25 2. This act shall take effect immediately. 26 27 **STATEMENT** 28 29 30 This bill requires school districts to provide instruction on diversity and inclusion as part of the implementation of the New 31 Jersey Student Learning Standards in Comprehensive Health and 32 33 Physical Education for students in grades 9 through 12.
