SYNOPSIS

Requires school districts to include instruction on certain events involving racial discrimination and social justice as part of implementation of New Jersey Student Learning Standards in Social Studies for middle school students.

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1 AN ACT concerning public school instruction on certain events in 2 United States history and supplementing chapter 35 of Title 18A 3 of the New Jersey Statutes. 4 5 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State 6 of New Jersey: 7 8 1. a. A board of education shall include instruction on certain 9 events in United States history, which involve racial discrimination 10 and social justice, in an appropriate place in the curriculum of 11 middle school students as part of the school district's 12 implementation of the New Jersey Student Learning Standards in 13 Social Studies. The instruction shall include information on the 14 following events: 15 (1) the death of Emmett Till in 1955, the circumstances 16 surrounding his death, and the events following his death, including 17 the role his death played as an important catalyst for the Civil 18 Rights Movement; (2) the Civil Rights Movement in the 1950s and the 1960s; 19 20 (3) civil unrest stemming from racial discrimination that 21 occurred during the 1990s including, but not limited to, the death of 22 Rodney King and the ensuing riots that occurred in Los Angeles, 23 California; and 24 (4) the death of George Floyd in 2020, the circumstances 25 surrounding his death, and the events following his death, including 26 the international protests against excessive police force that were 27 triggered as a result of his death. b. The Commissioner of Education shall provide school districts 28 29 with age-appropriate sample learning activities and resources 30 designed to enhance students' overall understanding of the events 31 enumerated in subsection a. of this section. 32 33 2. This act shall take effect immediately and shall first apply to 34 the first full school year following the date of enactment. 35 36 37 **STATEMENT** 38 39 This bill would require school districts to provide to middle 40 school students instruction on certain events that occurred 41 throughout United States history, which involve issues around racial 42 discrimination and social justice. Specifically, the bill would require instruction on: the death of Emmett Till in 1955; the Civil 43 44 Rights Movement in the 1950s and the 1960s; civil unrest stemming 45 from racial discrimination that occurred during the 1990s including, but not limited to, the death of Rodney King and the ensuing riots 46 that occurred in Los Angeles, California; and the death of George 47 48 Floyd in 2020. Under the bill, the Commissioner of Education will
