SYNOPSIS

Requires public and local utilities to provide notice to residential customers of available relief measures during coronavirus disease 2019 pandemic.

CURRENT VERSION OF TEXT

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AN ACT requiring public and local utilities to provide notice of 1 2 certain relief measures during the coronavirus disease 2019 3 pandemic. 4 5 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State 6 of New Jersey: 7 1. a. A public utility and local utility shall notify, in a form and 8 9 manner determined by the public utility and local utility, respectively, 10 each of its residential customers of information and resources available to residential customers concerning public utility and local utility 11 12 service and bill payment assistance during the coronavirus 2019 13 pandemic. b. The notification shall include, but not be limited to, 14 15 information concerning any: 16 (1) moratorium in effect on the disconnection, discontinuance, or 17 termination of public utility or local utility service; 18 (2) deferred bill payment agreement program; 19 (3) bill payment assistance program; ¹[and]¹ (4) arrearage for giveness program 1 ; and 20 21 (5) moratorium in effect on rate increases or on the imposition of 22 late fees, interest, or liens for late payments¹. 23 c. A public utility and local utility shall provide the notification required, pursuant to subsection a. of this section, ¹[on a quarterly] 24 basis in the same manner and frequency that the customer receives a 25 regular bill,¹ until 18 months after the date of the termination of 26 Executive Order No. 103 of 2020, which authorized the State of 27 Emergency in response to the coronavirus 2019 pandemic. ¹A public 28 utility and local utility shall publish the required information 29 prominently on its website.¹ 30 d. ¹[The Department of Community Affairs, in consultation with 31 32 the Board of Public Utilities, shall compile information on State and 33 federal policies and programs concerning public utility and local utility 34 service and bill payment assistance, which shall be made available to 35 each public utility and local utility, and shall be included in the notice 36 required by subsection a. of this section.] Nothing in this section shall be construed to permit a local utility to establish or administer a bill 37 payment assistance program not authorized by law.¹ 38 39 e. As used in this section: "Coronavirus 2019" means the coronavirus disease 2019, as 40 announced by the World Health Organization on February 11, 2020, 41 42 and first identified in Wuhan, China. 43 "Local utility" means any sewerage authority created pursuant to 44 the "sewerage authorities law," P.L.1946, c.138 (C.40:14A-1 et seq.); 45 any utilities authority created pursuant to the "municipal and county

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utilities authorities law," P.L.1957, c.183 (C.40:14B-1 et seq.); or any 1 2 municipal, county, or regional utility, authority, commission, special district, or other corporate entity, not regulated by the Board of Public 3 4 Utilities, that provides electricity, gas, heat, power, sewer, or water 5 service. 6 "Public utility" means a public utility, defined pursuant to R.S.48:2-13, providing electric, gas, sewer, or water service to 7 residential customers. 8 9
