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**SYNOPSIS**

Requires public and local utilities to provide notice to residential customers of available relief measures during coronavirus disease 2019 pandemic.

1 AN ACT requiring public and local utilities to provide notice of  
2 certain relief measures during the coronavirus disease 2019  
3 pandemic.

5 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State  
6 of New Jersey:

7  
8 1. a. A public utility and local utility shall notify, in a form and  
9 manner determined by the public utility and local utility, respectively,  
10 each of its residential customers of information and resources available  
11 to residential customers concerning public utility and local utility  
12 service and bill payment assistance during the coronavirus 2019  
13 pandemic.

14 b. The notification shall include, but not be limited to,  
15 information concerning any:

16 (1) moratorium in effect on the disconnection, discontinuance, or  
17 termination of public utility or local utility service;

18 (2) deferred bill payment agreement program;

19 (3) bill payment assistance program; <sup>1</sup>**[and]**<sup>1</sup>

20 (4) arrearage forgiveness program <sup>1</sup>; and

21 (5) moratorium in effect on rate increases or on the imposition of  
22 late fees, interest, or liens for late payments<sup>1</sup>.

23 c. A public utility and local utility shall provide the notification  
24 required, pursuant to subsection a. of this section, <sup>1</sup>**[on a quarterly]**  
25 **basis]** in the same manner and frequency that the customer receives a  
26 regular bill,<sup>1</sup> until 18 months after the date of the termination of  
27 Executive Order No. 103 of 2020, which authorized the State of  
28 Emergency in response to the coronavirus 2019 pandemic. <sup>1</sup>A public  
29 utility and local utility shall publish the required information  
30 prominently on its website.<sup>1</sup>

31 d. <sup>1</sup>**[The Department of Community Affairs, in consultation with**  
32 **the Board of Public Utilities, shall compile information on State and**  
33 **federal policies and programs concerning public utility and local utility**  
34 **service and bill payment assistance, which shall be made available to**  
35 **each public utility and local utility, and shall be included in the notice**  
36 **required by subsection a. of this section.]** Nothing in this section shall  
37 be construed to permit a local utility to establish or administer a bill  
38 payment assistance program not authorized by law.<sup>1</sup>

39 e. As used in this section:

40 "Coronavirus 2019" means the coronavirus disease 2019, as  
41 announced by the World Health Organization on February 11, 2020,  
42 and first identified in Wuhan, China.

43 "Local utility" means any sewerage authority created pursuant to  
44 the "sewerage authorities law," P.L.1946, c.138 (C.40:14A-1 et seq.);  
45 any utilities authority created pursuant to the "municipal and county

- 1 utilities authorities law," P.L.1957, c.183 (C.40:14B-1 et seq.); or any  
2 municipal, county, or regional utility, authority, commission, special  
3 district, or other corporate entity, not regulated by the Board of Public  
4 Utilities, that provides electricity, gas, heat, power, sewer, or water  
5 service.
- 6 "Public utility" means a public utility, defined pursuant to  
7 R.S.48:2-13, providing electric, gas, sewer, or water service to  
8 residential customers.
