Notwithstanding the provisions of this section to the 33 contrary, the Commissioner of Education may exempt a school 34 district, upon request, from the postponement of the comprehensive 35 review required pursuant to this section] A school district that is 36 required to undergo a comprehensive review in the 2020-2021 school year and was not designated as a high performing district pursuant to 37 section 14 of P.L.1975, c.212 (C.18A:7A-14) in the school district's 38 most recent comprehensive review shall undergo a comprehensive 39 40 review under the New Jersey Quality Single Accountability 41 Continuum in the 2020-2021 school year, except that such a district may postpone its comprehensive review until the 2021-2022 school 42 43 year if the district provides written notification to the Commissioner of 44 Education that it is not able to complete the review due to the impacts

45 of the COVID-19 pandemic.
