1 AN ACT concerning voting fraud and supplementing Title 52 of the  
2 Revised Statutes.

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4 **BE IT ENACTED** *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*  
5 *of New Jersey:*

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7 1. The Attorney General shall create a voting fraud task force  
8 in the Division of Criminal Justice, Specialized Crimes Bureau to  
9 investigate and prosecute crimes involving voting fraud.

10 The task force shall be comprised of members of State, county,  
11 and municipal law enforcement agencies, as determined by the  
12 Attorney General, and shall utilize a coordinated law enforcement  
13 strategy to address voting fraud in this State.

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15 2. This act shall take effect on the first day of the sixth month  
16 next following enactment.

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19 STATEMENT

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21 This bill requires the Attorney General to create a voting fraud  
22 task force in the Division of Criminal Justice, Specialized Crimes  
23 Bureau. The purpose of the task force is to investigate and  
24 prosecute crimes involving voting fraud.

25 Under the bill, the task force is to be comprised of members of  
26 State, county, and municipal law enforcement agencies, as  
27 determined by the Attorney General, and is to utilize a coordinated  
28 law enforcement strategy to address voting fraud in this State.
