Subject to the availability of federal funds provided or 2 made accessible to the State via federal block grant funds allocated 3 to the State from the federal "Coronavirus Relief Fund" established 4 pursuant to the federal "Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act)," Pub.L.116-136, or any other federal 5 funds made available to the State in response to the coronavirus 6 7 disease 2019 (COVID-19) pandemic, \$15,000,000 from such 8 federal funds shall be made available to the New Jersey Economic 9 Development Authority for the purposes set forth in subsection b. of 10 this section. 11 <u>b.</u>  $^{2}(1)^{2}$  <u>The funds made available to the New Jersey Economic</u> 12 Development Authority pursuant to subsection a. of this section 13 shall be reserved by the authority to provide financial support, by 14 way of grants, to businesses and nonprofits. <sup>2</sup>The authority may use not more than five percent of the funds to defray any administrative 15 16 expenses incurred in the implementation of this section. 17 (2) Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph (1) of this 18 subsection to the contrary, the authority may transfer the 19 uncommitted balance of any funds made available pursuant to this 20 section to any program established pursuant to 21 <u>P.L.</u>, c. (C.</u> 23 ) (pending before the Legislature as Assembly 24 Bill No. 5445 or Senate Bill No. 3520 of 2021), 25 P.L. , c. (C. ) (pending before the Legislature as Assembly 26 Bill No. 5444 or Senate Bill No. 3524 of 2021), or P.L., c. (C.) (pending before the Legislature as Assembly 27 Bill No. 5447 or Senate Bill No. 3521 of 2021). The authority shall 28 29 submit notice to the Joint Budget Oversight Committee no less than 30 five calendar days before the date of the transfer. At minimum, the 31 notice shall indicate the amount of the transferred funds and the purpose for which the funds are transferred.<sup>2</sup> 32 c. The New Jersey Economic Development Authority shall 33 34 establish the size of the awards and eligibility of entities in subsection b. of this section to meet the needs of businesses and 35 nonprofits in responding to the public health crisis.<sup>1</sup> 36 37 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

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
