Requires Commissioner of Corrections to appoint workforce skills training development officer to administer, enhance, and supplement inmate workforce skills training programming.

BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:

- 1. Section 1 of P.L. 2009, c.330 (C.30:4-92.1) is amended to read as follows:
- 9 1. The Commissioner of Corrections, in consultation with the 10 Commissioner of Labor and Workforce Development, shall establish a mandatory workforce skills training program in each 11 12 State correctional facility under the jurisdiction of the Department 13 of Corrections. The program shall be administered by a workforce skills training development officer who shall be appointed by the 14 15 Commissioner of Corrections to enhance and supplement the workforce skills training programming currently available to 16 17 inmates in each State correctional facility. In administering the 18 mandatory workforce training program in each State Correctional

<u>facility</u>, the workforce skills training development officer shall:

- (1) improve upon the facility's most successful workforce skills training program offerings as determined by the rate of enrollment and completion of the programs;
- (2) introduce new workforce skills training program offerings to inmates of the facility; and
- (3) provide workforce skills training programming, to be modified as needed, which is consistent with actual post-release employment opportunities and reflects the State's emerging industry and business workforce needs.
- a. The requirement of participating in a workforce skills training program shall apply to an inmate who:
- 31 (1) is in the custody of the Department of Corrections on the 32 effective date of P.L.2009, c.330 (C.30:4-92.1 et al.);
 - (2) has 18 months or more remaining to be served before a mandatory release date; and
- (3) is not exempted due to a medical, developmental, or learningdisability.
- 37 b. The mandatory workforce skills training program 38 requirement may be deferred for an inmate who is serving a 39 sentence exceeding 10 years.
- 40 c. The workforce skills training program shall contain a 41 computer literacy component, including instruction on word 42 processing, typing, Internet navigation, and use of e-mail.
- d. An inmate who satisfactorily participates in the mandatory workforce skills training program shall be eligible for commutation time for good behavior pursuant to R.S.30:4-140 or credits for

diligent application to work and other institutional assignments pursuant to R.S.30:4-92.

- e. The commissioner shall report to the State Parole Board the progress of an inmate participating in the mandatory workforce skills training program.
- f. The commissioner, in consultation with the workforce skills training development officer and the Commissioner of Labor and Workforce Development, shall promulgate, pursuant to the "Administrative Procedure Act," P.L.1968, c.410 (C.52:14B-1 et seq.) the rules and regulations that are necessary to implement the provisions of P.L.2009, c.330 (C.30:4-92.1 et al.). These rules and regulations shall include, but not be limited to, provisions to:
- (1) determine when an inmate shall be exempted from the mandatory workforce skills training requirement due to a medical, developmental, or learning disability as authorized under paragraph (3) of subsection a. of this section; and
- (2) authorize these exempted inmates to voluntarily participate in the mandatory workforce skills training program.
- g. In order to administer, enhance, and supplement the workforce skills training programming available at a State correctional facility in accordance with this section, the workforce skills training development officer, on a regular basis but not less than once per year, shall meet with a representative of the New Jorsey Phainage and Industry Association.
