BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:

1. The Division of Veterans' [Administrative] Healthcare¹ Services in the Department of Military and Veterans' Affairs shall ensure that each veterans' memorial home shall communicate updates to each veteran's guardian appointed pursuant to section 1 of P.L.1993, c.281 (C.38A:3-2b2 et seq.), and each person otherwise having the veteran's power of attorney, through a minimum of two communication means, which shall include regular mail, email, text message, and voice.

2. This act shall take effect immediately.

EXPLANATION – Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted in the law.
