1	A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION providing for the convening of a
2	special session of the Legislature to address property tax relief
3	and reform in this State.

5	WHEREAS, New Jersey's property taxes, which support county and
6	municipal governments and the public schools, are among the
7	highest in the nation; and
8	WHEREAS, The current system of property taxation has placed an
9	enormous burden on the residents of this State; and
10	WHEREAS, This State's high property taxes result from the
1	inequitable and nonuniform application of school funding; and
12	WHEREAS, There is a dire need to reform property taxes which are
13	stifling the State's economy, making home ownership impossible
14	for many, and disproportionately burdening the elderly, the
15	young, and low income families; and
16	WHEREAS, Remedying the problems associated with high property
17	taxes is a legislative responsibility; and
18	WHEREAS, There is a need for the Legislature to convene in a
19	special session dedicated solely to addressing property tax relief
20	and reform in this State; now, therefore,
21	
22	BE IT RESOLVED by the General Assembly of the State of New
23	Jersey (the Senate concurring):
24	
25	1. The presiding officer of each House of the Legislature shall
26	convene a special session of that house, within seven days of final
27	passage of this concurrent resolution, which shall be devoted solely
28	to consideration of the issue of property tax relief and reform in this
29	State and which shall devise and consider ways of implementing
30	that relief and reform. The presiding officer and the minority leader
31	of each house shall each present bills to be considered by that house
32	at the special session and each such bill shall be voted on by the
33	members of that house.

36	STATEMENT
37	
38	This concurrent resolution provides for the convening of a
39	special session of the Legislature for the purpose of considering
10	property tax relief and reform.
