2	"World Day of Remembrance for Road Traffic Victims."

4	WHEREAS, The third Sunday in November is globally recognized as
5	the World Day of Remembrance for Road Traffic Victims to
6	remember the millions of people who have been killed on the
7	world's roads as well as to recognize the millions who have
8	survived but suffered serious injuries; and
9	WHEREAS, Road traffic deaths and injuries are particularly difficult
10	for the family of victims due to the suddenness and violence
11	associated with such deaths and injuries, typically leaving the
12	family and friends of victims traumatized; and
13	WHEREAS, In New Jersey, the most densely populated state in the
14	country, raising awareness about traffic safety and alerting the
15	State's residents about the devastation that is caused by road traffic
16	deaths and injuries is critically important to the public welfare and
17	helps to ease some of the anguish felt by the families and friends of
18	victims; and
19	WHEREAS, Candlelight vigils, educational seminars, moments of
20	silence, and other events are held around the world on the World
21	Day of Remembrance for Road Traffic Victims to memorialize the
22	victims of road traffic incidents; and
23	WHEREAS, It is altogether fitting and proper for the State of New
24	Jersey to join the rest of the world by designating the third Sunday
25	in November as "World Day of Remembrance for Road Traffic
26	Victims"; now, therefore,

28	BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate and General Assembly of the
