23	biochemists and biophysicists; and
24	WHEREAS, the State's location in the Northeast provides
25	manufacturers with access to some of the most affluent consumers
26	in the country, as well as the infrastructure for wide-scale
27	distribution of manufacturing products and services; and
28	WHEREAS, It is altogether fitting and appropriate to recognize the
29	important role the manufacturing industry plays in the State by
30	designating the first week of October of each year as Manufacturing
