Notwithstanding the provisions of Title 19 of the Revised 9 Statutes, or any other law, rule, or regulation to the contrary, the 10 requirements to collect petition signatures via an online form and to 11 submit petitions online implemented by the Secretary of State, county 12 clerks, and municipal clerks pursuant to paragraphs 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5 of Executive Order No. 105 (2020) and paragraphs 1, 2, 3, and 4 of 13 14 Executive Order No. 132 (2020) shall be implemented to include any pending petition for all remaining elections in 2020 and for any other 15 16 election taking place thereafter for the duration of the COVID-19 17 Public Health Emergency and State of Emergency declared by the 18 Governor under Executive Order No. 103 (2020). 19 The electronic signature and submission requirements for b. 20 petitions shall apply to the: collection of signatures for any candidate, ¹including a 21 (1) candidate for a board of education,¹ delegate, recall, initiative, 22 23 referendum, or other petition required to be filed prior to an election; 24 (2) delivery of petitions to the Secretary of State, county clerks, 25 and municipal clerks; 26 acceptance by the Secretary of State, county clerks, and (3) municipal clerks of electronic petitions with signatures collected via 27 28 the online form ¹<u>or forms</u>¹, except that handwritten signatures obtained prior to the effective date of this section shall also be 29 30 accepted electronically and in person; and verification of signatures, notarization of petitions, and 31 (4) 32 submission of oaths to accompany petitions, as may be required by 33 law c. The Secretary of State, in consultation with the Department of 34 Law and Public Safety, shall develop a generic template ¹or templates¹ 35 for the online form ¹or forms¹ to be used for the collection of 36 37 signatures and submission of petitions. The petition's respective filing 38 officer shall develop the electronic procedures for signature verification, petition notarization, and submission of oaths to meet the 39 requirements of current law. 40
