The instruction shall: (1) highlight and promote diversity ¹, including economic 15 diversity¹, equity, inclusion, tolerance¹, and belonging ¹[on topics 16 including: in connection with gender and sexual orientation [;],1 17 race and ethnicity $^1 \[;]$ 1 disabilities $^1 \[;]$ 1 religious tolerance; 18 ¹[and unconscious bias; and]¹ 19 (2) ¹examine the impact that unconscious bias and economic 20 21 disparities have at both an individual level and on society as a whole; 22 (3)¹ encourage safe, welcoming, and inclusive environments for 23 24 all students regardless of race or ethnicity, sexual and gender 25 identities, mental and physical disabilities, and religious beliefs. 26 c.
