1 AN ACT concerning resident tuition rates for dependent children of
2 United States military personnel and amending P.L.1985, c.231.

4 **BE IT ENACTED** *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
5 *of New Jersey:*

7 1. Section 1 of P.L.1985, c.231 (C.18A:62-4.1) is amended to
8 read as follows:

9 1. a. United States military personnel and their dependents
10 who are living in New Jersey and are attending public institutions
11 of higher education in New Jersey shall be regarded as residents of
12 the State for the purpose of determining tuition.

b. A dependent child of United States military personnel who attended high school in New Jersey for a minimum of three years shall be regarded by a public institution of higher education in New Jersey as a resident of the State for the purpose of determining tuition, regardless of where the dependent child resides upon enrollment in the institution.

21 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

26 Provides resident tuition rate to certain non-resident dependent
27 children of United States military personnel attending public
28 institutions of higher education.
