1    **AN ACT** concerning military members and supplementing Title 38A  
2       of the New Jersey Statutes.

4       **BE IT ENACTED** *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*  
5       *of New Jersey:*

7       1. There is established the “Military Pro Bono Program” in  
8       New Jersey’s Department of Military and Veterans Affairs to  
9       provide active-duty service members and veterans of the military  
10      pro bono legal representation in various areas of civil law including,  
11      but not limited to, family law, estate planning, employment law,  
12      immigration law, debtor-creditor law and military administrative  
13      law.

15      2. The Adjutant General of the Department of Military and  
16      Veterans' Affairs, pursuant to the "Administrative Procedure Act,"  
17      P.L.1968, c.410 (C.52:14B-1 et seq.), shall adopt rules and  
18      regulations to effectuate the purposes of this act.

20      3. This act shall take effect immediately.
