A public school that includes any of the grades seven through 12 and that issues student identification cards shall have printed on the back of the student identification cards the telephone number for <sup>1</sup>[a suicide prevention hotline] the New Jersey Suicide Prevention Hopeline (NJ Hopeline) and contact information for a crisis text line <sup>1</sup>.

An institution of higher education that issues student identification cards shall have printed on the back of the student identification cards the telephone number for <sup>1</sup>[a suicide prevention hotline] the New Jersey Suicide Prevention Hopeline (NJ Hopeline) and contact information for a crisis text line <sup>1</sup>.

<sup>1</sup>3. A public school that includes any of the grades seven through 12 and that issues student identification cards, and an institution of higher education that issues student identification cards, may, in addition to the telephone number for the NJ Hopeline and contact information for a crisis text line, provide contact information for the National Suicide Prevention Lifeline, an on-campus crisis center, or any other mental health support service. <sup>1</sup>

<sup>1</sup>[3.Section 1 of this] <u>4. This</u> act shall take effect in the first full school year <sup>1</sup>[following the date of enactment, and section 2 of this act shall take effect] <u>or</u> in the first full academic year <sup>1</sup>, as <u>applicable</u>, <sup>1</sup> following the date of enactment.
