BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:

7 1. a. The Chief Administrator of the New Jersey Motor 8 Vehicle Commission, in consultation with the Commissioner of 9 Human Services, the Superintendent of the Division of State Police 10 within the Department of Law and Public Safety, and at least one organization that advocates on behalf of persons who have been 11 12 diagnosed with an autism spectrum disorder, shall design and make 13 available blue envelopes that may be utilized by a person who has been diagnosed with an autism spectrum disorder. 14

15 b. The blue envelopes developed pursuant to subsection a. of this section shall: (1) be of a color shade easily recognizable to law 16 17 enforcement officers; (2) be capable of holding a person's driver's 18 license, motor vehicle registration card, and insurance identification 19 card; (3) provide written information on the outside of the envelope 20 identifying the envelope holder as a person who has been diagnosed with an autism spectrum disorder; and (4) provide written guidance 21 22 to assist law enforcement officers in effectively communicating 23 with a person who has been diagnosed with an autism spectrum 24 disorder.

c. The chief administrator shall, in consultation with the Commissioner of Human Services, establish the documentation required to be produced by a person who has been diagnosed with an autism spectrum disorder, or by the parent, guardian, or caregiver of the person, in order to receive an envelope issued pursuant to subsection a. of this section.

STATEMENT

38 This bill requires the Chief Administrator of the New Jersey 39 Motor Vehicle Commission (chief administrator), in consultation with the Commissioner of Human Services (commissioner), the 40 Superintendent of the Division of State Police within the 41 Department of Law and Public Safety, and at least one organization 42 43 that advocates on behalf of persons who have been diagnosed with 44 an autism spectrum disorder, to design and make available blue 45 envelopes that may be utilized by a person who has been diagnosed 46 with an autism spectrum disorder.

47 Under the bill, the blue envelopes are required to: (1) be of a 48 color shade easily recognizable to law enforcement officers; (2) be

capable of holding a person's driver's license, motor vehicle 1 2 registration card, and insurance identification card; (3) provide 3 written information on the outside of the envelope identifying the 4 envelope holder as a person who has been diagnosed with an autism 5 spectrum disorder; and (4) provide written guidance to assist law 6 enforcement officers in effectively communicating with a person 7 who has been diagnosed with an autism spectrum disorder. 8 The bill also requires that the chief administrator, in consultation

9 with the commissioner, establish the documentation required to be 10 produced by a person who has been diagnosed with an autism 11 spectrum disorder, or by the parent, guardian, or caregiver of the 12 person, in order to receive an envelope.
