2 funds and amending P.L.2009, c.86.

4 **BE IT ENACTED** *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*  
5 *of New Jersey:*

7 1. Section 1 of P.L.2009, c.86 (C.52:32-1a) is amended to read  
8 as follows:

9 1. Any flag of the United States, POW-MIA flag, or flag of the  
10 State of New Jersey purchased with State funds shall be  
11 manufactured in the United States.

14 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

17 STATEMENT

19 This bill would require that any POW-MIA flag purchased with  
20 State funds be manufactured in the United States. Under current  
21 law, any flag of the United States of America or flag of the State of  
22 New Jersey purchased with State funds should be manufactured in  
23 the United States.
