This act shall take effect immediately. 15 16 17 **STATEMENT** 18 This bill would require that any POW-MIA flag purchased with 19 20 State funds be manufactured in the United States. Under current law, any flag of the United States of America or flag of the State of 21 New Jersey purchased with State funds should be manufactured in 22 23 the United States.
