1 AN ACT concerning lead service lines and supplementing Title 58
2 of the Revised Statutes.

4 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
5 *of New Jersey:*

7 1. a. The Department of Environmental Protection shall
8 establish and maintain a searchable database, accessible to the
9 public on its Internet website, that identifies the location of all
10 service lines known to contain lead. The department shall update
11 the database in a timely manner to ensure that it reflects the most
12 current information known by the department.

13 b. As used in this section, “service line” means the pipe,
14 tubing, and fittings connecting a water main to a building or
15 structure.

17 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

STATEMENT

21

22 This bill would require the Department of Environmental
23 Protection to establish and maintain a searchable database,
24 accessible to the public on its website, that identifies the location of
25 all service lines known to contain lead. The department would be
26 required to update the database in a timely manner to ensure that it
27 reflects the most current information known by the department.
