**SYNOPSIS**

Makes fiscal year 2020 General Fund supplemental appropriation totaling \$1,000,000 for medical transportation costs for residents of Veterans' Memorial Homes.

1    **A SUPPLEMENT** to "An Act making appropriations for the support  
2       of the State Government and the several public purposes for the  
3       fiscal year ending June 30, 2020 and regulating the disbursement  
4       thereof, " approved June 30, 2019 (P.L.2019, c.150).

6       **BE IT ENACTED** *by the Senate and the General Assembly of the*  
7       *State of New Jersey:*

9       1. In addition to the amounts appropriated under P.L.2019,  
10      c.150, there is appropriated out of the General Fund the following  
11      sum for the purpose specified:

**80 Special Government Services**

**83 Services to Veterans**

15      2. The funds hereby appropriated shall be allocated in  
16      equivalent amounts to each of the Veterans' Memorial Homes for  
17      the purpose of transporting residents to medical appointments.

22               **STATEMENT**

23  
24      This bill amends the current fiscal year 2020 appropriations act  
25      to provide a total supplemental appropriation of \$1,000,000 from  
26      the General Fund to fund medical transportation costs for residents  
27      of the Veterans' Memorial Homes. The funding is required to be  
28      divided and distributed equally among the homes
