Requires DOT Commissioner to advertise availability of certain transportation programs and services.

1 AN ACT concerning the advertising of certain transportation 2 programs and services and amending P.L.1973, c.126. 3 4 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State 5 of New Jersey: 6 7 1. Section 2 of P.L.1973, c.126 (C.27:1A-65) is amended to 8 read as follows: 9 2. For the purposes of P.L.1973, c.126 (C.27:1A-64 et seq.), 10 unless the context clearly indicates otherwise: 11 "Access Link service" means the paratransit service implemented 12 by the New Jersey Transit Corporation for the purposes of complying with the "Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990," 13 Pub.L.101-336 (42 U.S.C. s.12101 et seq.). 14 15 "Carrier" means any individual, copartnership, association, 16 corporation, joint stock company, public agency, trustee, or receiver 17 operating motor buses or rail passenger service on established 18 routes within this State or between points in this State and points in 19 adjacent states. 20 "Commissioner" means the Commissioner of Transportation; provided, however, that the commissioner may delegate any of the 21 22 commissioner's powers or duties under P.L.1973, c.126 (C.27:1A-23 64 et seq.) to any subordinate division, agency, or employee of the 24 Department of Transportation or to the New Jersey Transit 25 Corporation. "Disabled veteran" means "disabled veteran" as defined in 26 27 N.J.S.11A:5-1. "Motor bus" means "autobus" as defined in R.S.48:4-1, and 28 29 includes those autobuses, commonly called jitneys, as defined in 30 R.S.48:16-23. 31 "Offpeak times" means the hours from 9:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. and from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. during the weekdays, and all day on 32 33 Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays. 34 "Person with disabilities" means any individual who, by reason 35 of illness, injury, age, congenital malfunction, or other permanent or temporary incapacity or disability, is unable without special 36 37 facilities or special planning or design to utilize mass transportation 38 facilities and services as effectively as persons who are not so 39 affected. A "person with disabilities" shall include a person 40 determined by the New Jersey Transit Corporation to be eligible for 41 its Access Link service. "Senior citizen" means any individual 62 years of age or over. 42 43 (cf: P.L.2017, c.131, s.107) 44 45 2. Section 8 of P.L.1973, c.126 (C.27:1A-71) is amended to read as follows: 46

The commissioner is hereby authorized to hire, employ, or 2 assign secretarial, clerical, and other personnel as shall be required 3 for complying with the provisions of P.L.1973, c.126 (C.27:1A-4 64 et seq.). The commissioner [may] shall also expend a reasonable sum, not to exceed \$50,000 annually, for advertising to 5 6 make senior citizens, persons with disabilities, and disabled 7 veterans aware of the program [and], the availability and cost of 8 the reduced fares thereunder, the hours when reduced fares may be 9 used, the public transportation facilities made accessible to persons 10 with disabilities, and the availability of other transportation services 11 offered to the public for use by persons with disabilities including 12 Access Link service. 13 (cf: P.L.2017, c.131, s.111) 14 15 3. This act shall take effect immediately. 16 17 18 **STATEMENT** 19 20 bill requires the Commissioner of Transportation This 21 (commissioner) to advertise the availability of the program that 22 provides motor bus and rail passenger service for senior citizens 23 and persons with disabilities at reduced fares, the cost of those 24 fares, and the hours when reduced fares may be used. The bill also 25 requires the commissioner to advertise the public transportation 26 facilities made accessible to persons with disabilities and the 27 availability of other transportation services offered to the public for use by persons with disabilities, including the Access Link 28 29 paratransit service operated by the New Jersey Transit Corporation.
