12	² [any] ² insurance coverages afforded the school's registered and
13	enrolled student population beginning July 1, 2020 1 or for the
14	purposes of ² [any] ² insurance coverages afforded the school's
15	employees beginning July 1, 2020 ¹ , be considered included in the
16	enrolled and registered student population ¹ or be considered as a
17	school employee, as applicable, while attending the graduation
18	exercises.
19	² b. As used in this section:
20	"Insurance" means, in the case of a student, student accident
21	insurance and general liability insurance, and in the case of an
22	employee, general liability insurance; and
23	"School" means a school district or charter school high school. ²
