SYNOPSIS

Ensures insurance coverage for certain persons attending school graduation exercises in July and August of 2020.

1 AN ACT concerning school graduation exercise in July ¹and August
2 of¹ 2020.

4 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
5 of New Jersey:

7 1. ²a.² Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary,
8 individuals attending school-sponsored graduation exercises
9 between July 1, 2020 and ¹**[July]** August¹ 31, 2020, who have
10 graduated from the school ¹or were employed by the school¹ in the
11 immediately preceding school year shall, for the purposes of
12 ²**[any]**² insurance coverages afforded the school's registered and
13 enrolled student population beginning July 1, 2020 ¹or for the
14 purposes of ²**[any]**² insurance coverages afforded the school's
15 employees beginning July 1, 2020¹, be considered included in the
16 enrolled and registered student population ¹or be considered as a
17 school employee, as applicable,¹ while attending the graduation
18 exercises.

19 ²b. As used in this section:

20 "Insurance" means, in the case of a student, student accident
21 insurance and general liability insurance, and in the case of an
22 employee, general liability insurance; and

23 "School" means a school district or charter school high school.²

25 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
