AN ACT establishing the "New Jersey Transit ADA Task Force." 1 2 3 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State 4 of New Jersey: 5 6 1. There is established the "New Jersey Transit ADA Task 7 Force." 8 a. The task force shall consist of the following nine members: 9 (1) the Commissioner of Transportation, ex officio, or the 10 commissioner's designee; 11 (2) the Executive Director of the New Jersey Transit 12 Corporation, ex officio, or the executive director's designee; (3) three public members appointed by the Governor, including 13 14 one member who shall be a representative from an organization 15 whose members advocate for persons with disabilities; 16 (4) two public members appointed by the President of the 17 Senate; and (5) two public members appointed by the Speaker of the General 18 19 Assembly. 20 b. The members of the task force shall serve without compensation, but may be reimbursed for necessary and actual 21 22 expenses incurred in the performance of their duties to the extent 23 that funds are made available for that purpose. 24 25 The task force shall organize as soon as practicable 2. a. 26 following the appointment of a majority of its members, but no later than 60 days after the effective date of this act. Vacancies in the 27 membership of the task force shall be filled in the same manner as 28 29 the original appointments were made. The task force shall select a 30 chairperson from among its members and may appoint a secretary 31 who need not be a member of the task force. The task force shall 32 meet at the call of the chairperson. 33 b. The New Jersey Transit Corporation shall provide stenographic, clerical, and other administrative assistance and 34 professional staff <sup>1</sup>, including but not limited to corporation 35 engineers and architects,<sup>1</sup> as the task force requires to carry out its 36 37 work. The task force shall be entitled to call to its assistance and avail itself of the services of the employees of any State, county, or 38 39 municipal department, board, bureau, commission, or agency as it 40 may require and as may be available for its purposes. 41 42 3. a. The task force shall study all terminals, stations, stops, and equipment owned or operated by the New Jersey Transit 43 44 Corporation and all terminals, stations, stops, and equipment owned 45 or operated by an entity under contract with the corporation for

1 compliance with the provisions of the Americans with Disabilities 2 Act. The task force shall: 3 (1) study and compile a list of all upgrades that need to be completed in order to ensure that the terminals, stations, stops, and 4 5 equipment owned or operated by the corporation or an entity under contract with the corporation are in full compliance with the 6 7 Americans with Disabilities Act; (2) study and determine the cost to complete each upgrade 8 9 identified in paragraph (1) of subsection a. of this section; and 10 (3) study and determine whether ramps may be installed at 11 terminals, stations, and stops where elevators are not available or 12 where elevators are not in compliance with the provisions of the Americans with Disabilities Act. 13 14 For purposes of this section, "Americans with Disabilities Act" 15 means the "Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990" (42 U.S.C. s.12101 et seq.), any acts amendatory or supplementary thereto, and 16 any regulations and standards adopted thereunder. 17 18 19 4. The task force shall prepare and submit a report of its 20 findings and recommendations that comply with the provisions of section 3 of this act to the Governor and, pursuant to section 2 of 21 P.L.1991, c.164 (C.52:14-19.1), to the Legislature no later than two 22 23 years after the effective date of this act. The task force shall expire 24 upon submission of this report. 25 26 5. This act shall take effect immediately and shall expire upon

27 submission of the report required by section 4 of this act.
