1 AN ACT concerning influenza vaccinations and supplementing Title 2 26 of the Revised Statutes. 3 4 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State 5 of New Jersey: 6 7 1. Notwithstanding any law, order, rule, or regulation to the 8 contrary, no State, county, or local government employee, entity, or 9 elected official, and no private or public school shall directly or 10 indirectly require an individual who is 18 years of age or younger to undergo the administration of an influenza vaccine or any other 11 injection, medication, or procedure that is designed to provide 12 immunity from influenza. 13 14 15 2. This act shall take effect immediately. 16 17 18 **STATEMENT** 19 20 This bill prohibits a government entity or school from requiring influenza vaccinations for persons who are 18 years of age or 21 22 younger. 23 Under the bill, no State, county, or local government employee, 24 entity, or elected official, and no private or public school is to 25 directly or indirectly require an individual who is 18 years of age or 26 younger to undergo the administration of an influenza vaccine or 27 any other injection, medication, or procedure that is designed to 28 provide immunity from influenza.
