2 Prosecutors Part of the Public Employees' Retirement System of 3 New Jersey and supplementing P.L.2001, c.366. 4 5 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State 6 of New Jersey: 7 8 A member of the Prosecutors Part of the Public 1. a. 9 Employees' Retirement System may establish credit in the 10 Prosecutors Part for credit purchased pursuant to sections 8 and 14 11 of P.L.1954, c.84 (C.43:15A-8 and 43:15A-14), section 2 of 12 P.L.1963, c.19 (C.43:15A-73.1) and section 1 of P.L.1991, c.444 13 (C.43:15A-73.4) except that the member shall pay the amount required by applying the factor, supplied by the actuary as being 14 15 applicable to membership in the Prosecutors Part as well as to the 16 member's age at the time of the purchase, to the member's salary at 17 that time, or to the highest annual compensation for service in this 18 State for which contributions shall have been made during any fiscal year of membership, whichever is highest. 19 20 b. A member of the Prosecutors Part may establish credit in the 21 Prosecutors Part for credit previously purchased and established in 22 the regular Public Employees' Retirement System by paying into the 23 annuity savings fund the amount of the difference between the 24 contribution that the member paid into the retirement system and 25 the contribution that would have been required if the member had 26 established the credit in the Prosecutors Part pursuant to subsection 27 a. of this section. 28 29 2. This act shall take effect immediately. 30 31 32 **STATEMENT** 33 34 This bill allows a member of the Prosecutors Part in the Public 35 Employees' Retirement System (PERS) to purchase and establish credit in the Prosecutors Part in the same manner as credit may be 36 37 purchased for the regular part of PERS, except that the amount paid by the member of the Prosecutors Part will be calculated to reflect 38 the cost of the benefits of the Prosecutors Part. 39 Current law provides benefits to members of the Prosecutors Part

40 41 in PERS superior to the benefits for regular PERS service credit and 42 imposes a higher employee contribution rate. PERS members who were prosecutors on January 7, 2002, the effective date of P.L.2001, 43 44 c.366 which established the Prosecutors Part, became members of 45 the Prosecutors Part and regular PERS service credit established 46 prior to January 7, 2002 was established in the Prosecutors Part without further assessment of cost to those prosecutors. Regular 47 PERS credit purchased after January 7, 2002 by persons who 48

became members of the Prosecutors Part on January 7, 2002 may not be established in the Part. Regular PERS credit, purchased or established by other PERS-covered service, of persons who become members of the Prosecutors Part after January 7, 2002 may not be established in the Part, except regular PERS credit of a constitutionally nominated and appointed county prosecutor may be credited in the Part.

8 The bill allows a member of the Prosecutors Part to establish 9 credit in the Prosecutors Part through the regular PERS purchase 10 process except that the member will pay the amount required by 11 applying the factor, supplied by the actuary as being applicable to 12 membership in the Prosecutors Part as well as to the member's age 13 at the time of the purchase, to the member's salary at that time, or to 14 the highest annual compensation for service in this State for which 15 contributions were made during any fiscal year of membership, 16 whichever is highest. In addition, a member of the Prosecutors Part 17 may establish credit in the Prosecutors Part for credit previously purchased and established in the regular Public Employees' 18 19 Retirement System by paying into the annuity savings fund the 20 amount of the difference between the contribution that the member 21 paid into the retirement system and the contribution that would have 22 been required if the member had made the purchase to establish 23 credit in the Prosecutors Part.
