15	This bill appropriates a total of \$87,444,690 from the "New
16	Jersey Library Construction Fund." Under the bill, \$86,484,040 is
17	appropriated to the State Librarian for the purpose of providing
18	project grants for the construction, reconstruction, development,
19	extension, improvement, and furnishing of New Jersey public
20	libraries. The bill also appropriates \$625,000 and \$335,650,
21	respectively, to the New Jersey Educational Facilities Authority and
22	the State Librarian for the administration of the "New Jersey

23 Library Construction Bond Act."
