

Appropriates \$29,886,172 to State Agriculture Development Committee for farmland preservation purposes.

AN ACT appropriating \$29,886,172 from various farmland
 preservation funds to the State Agriculture Development
 Committee for farmland preservation purposes.

BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:

8 1. a. There is appropriated to the State Agriculture 9 Development Committee the sum of \$23,298,172 in the following 10 subtotal amounts, listed in paragraphs (1) through (5) of this 11 subsection, to pay the cost of acquisition by the committee of 12 development easements on, or fee simple titles to, farmland, to 13 provide grants to counties and municipalities for up to 80 percent of 14 the cost of acquisition of fee simple titles to farmland, to provide 15 grants to qualifying tax-exempt non-profit organizations for up to 16 50 percent of the cost of acquisition of fee simple titles to farmland, 17 for farmland preservation purposes for projects approved as eligible 18 for such funding pursuant to the "Agricultural Retention and 19 Development Act," P.L.1983, c.32 (C.4:1C-11 et seq.), the "Green 20 Acres, Farmland and Historic Preservation, and Blue Acres Bond Act of 1995," P.L.1995, c.204, the "Garden State Preservation Trust 21 22 Act," P.L.1999, c.152 (C.13:8C-1 et seq.), the "Green Acres, 23 Farmland, Blue Acres, and Historic Preservation Bond Act of 24 2007," P.L.2007, c.119, the "Green Acres, Water Supply and 25 Floodplain Protection, and Farmland and Historic Preservation 26 Bond Act of 2009," P.L.2009, c.117, and the "Preserve New Jersey 27 Act," P.L.2016, c.12 (C.13:8C-43 et seq.):

(1) \$22,416,375 from dedicated corporation business tax
revenues pursuant to Article VIII, Section II, paragraph 6 of the
State Constitution from the "Preserve New Jersey Farmland
Preservation Fund," established pursuant to section 8 of the
"Preserve New Jersey Act," P.L.2016, c.12 (C.13:8C-50);

(2) \$599,712 from the "2009 Farmland Preservation Fund,"
established pursuant to section 18 of the "Green Acres, Water
Supply and Floodplain Protection, and Farmland and Historic
Preservation Bond Act of 2009," P.L.2009, c.117;

37 (3) \$141,233 from the "2007 Farmland Preservation Fund,"
38 established pursuant to section 18 of the "Green Acres, Farmland,
39 Blue Acres, and Historic Preservation Bond Act of 2007,"
40 P.L.2007, c.119;

41 (4) \$103,308 from the "Garden State Farmland Preservation
42 Fund," established pursuant to section 20 of P.L.1999, c.152
43 (C.13:8C-20); and

(5) \$37,544 .from the "1995 Farmland Preservation Fund,"
established pursuant to section 25 of the "Green Acres, Farmland
and Historic Preservation, and Blue Acres Bond Act of 1995,"
P.L.1995, c.204.

b. Any farmland acquired in fee simple with monies
appropriated pursuant to this section shall be offered for resale or
lease with agricultural deed restrictions approved by the committee.

5 There is appropriated from the "Preserve New Jersey 6 Farmland Preservation Fund," established pursuant to section 8 of 7 the "Preserve New Jersey Act," P.L.2016, c.12 (C.13:8C-50), from the "2009 Farmland Preservation Fund," established pursuant to 8 9 section 18 of the "Green Acres, Water Supply and Floodplain 10 Protection, and Farmland and Historic Preservation Bond Act of 2009," P.L.2009, c.117, from the "2007 Farmland Preservation 11 12 Fund," established pursuant to section 18 of the "Green Acres, 13 Farmland, Blue Acres, and Historic Preservation Bond Act of 2007," P.L.2007, c.119, from the "Garden State Farmland 14 15 Preservation Trust Fund," established pursuant to section 20 of 16 P.L.1999, c.152 (C.13:8C-20), from the "1999 Open Space Fund," 17 established pursuant to the "Open Space - Local Match Program of 18 the Fiscal Year 1999 annual appropriations act," P.L.1998, c.45, 19 from the "1995 Farmland Preservation Fund," established pursuant 20 to section 25 of the "Green Acres, Farmland and Historic 21 Preservation, and Blue Acres Bond Act of 1995," P.L.1995, c.204, 22 from the "1992 Farmland Preservation Fund," established pursuant 23 to section 24 of the "Green Acres, Clean Water, Farmland and 24 Historic Preservation Bond Act of 1992," P.L.1992, c.88, from the 25 "1989 Farmland Preservation Fund," established pursuant to section 26 22 of the "Open Space Preservation Bond Act of 1989," P.L.1989, 27 c.183, and from the "Farmland Preservation Fund," established pursuant to section 5 of the "Farmland Preservation Bond Act of 28 29 1981," P.L.1981, c.276, to the State Agriculture Development 30 Committee such sums from any additional proceeds which may 31 become available by the effective date of this act due to the lease or 32 conveyance of land or development easements acquired or funded 33 by the committee, for the purpose of providing for the cost of 34 acquisition by the committee of development easements and fee 35 simple titles to farmland for farmland preservation purposes 36 pursuant to subsection a. of section 1 of this act.

Any farmland acquired in fee simple with monies appropriated
pursuant to this section shall be offered for resale or lease with
agricultural deed restrictions approved by the committee.

3. There is appropriated to the State Agriculture Development
Committee the sum of \$2,253,000 from the "Preserve New Jersey
Farmland Preservation Fund," established pursuant to section 8 of
the "Preserve New Jersey Act," P.L.2016, c.12 (C.13:8C-50), for
the purpose of providing grants for stewardship activities as defined
pursuant to section 3 of P.L.2016, c.12 (C.13:8C-45), including soil
and water conservation project activities approved pursuant to

1 section 17 of P.L.1983, c.32 (C.4:1C-24) and deer-fencing activities 2 approved pursuant to section 5 of P.L.1983, c.32 (C.4:1C-5). 3 4 There is appropriated to the State Agriculture Development 4. 5 Committee the sum of \$4,335,000 from the "Preserve New Jersey Farmland Preservation Fund," established pursuant to section 8 of 6 7 the "Preserve New Jersey Act," P.L.2016, c.12 (C.13:8C-50), as 8 follows: 9 a. \$3,985,000 for the purpose of providing funding for 10 organizational, administrative and other work and services, including salaries, equipment, materials, and services necessary to 11 12 administer the applicable provisions of P.L.2016, c.12 (C.13:8C-43 13 et seq.); 14 b. \$250,000 for the purpose of providing funding for costs 15 associated with the acquisition of development easements on 16 farmland by the committee, including, but not limited to, appraisal, 17 survey, and title costs; and 18 \$100,000 for the purpose of providing for the review of c. 19 appraisals for farmland preservation programs administered by the 20 committee pursuant to P.L.2016, c.12 (C.13:8C-43 et seq.). 21 22 5. This act shall take effect immediately. 36 37 38 **STATEMENT** 39 40 This bill appropriates \$29,886,172 from various farmland 41 preservation funds to the State Agriculture Development Committee 42 (SADC) for certain farmland preservation purposes. Of the funding provided by the bill, \$23,298,172 is appropriated 43 44 to the SADC to pay the cost of acquisition by the SADC of 45 development easements on, or fee simple titles to, farmland, to 46 provide grants to counties and municipalities for up to 80 percent of the cost of acquisition of fee simple titles to farmland, and to 47 48 provide grants to qualifying tax exempt nonprofit organizations for

1 up to 50 percent of the cost of acquisition of fee simple titles to 2 farmland, for farmland preservation purposes for projects approved 3 as eligible for such funding pursuant to: the "Agricultural 4 Retention and Development Act"; the "Green Acres, Farmland and 5 Historic Preservation, and Blue Acres Bond Act of 1995"; the "Garden State Preservation Trust Act"; the "Green Acres, 6 7 Farmland, Blue Acres, and Historic Preservation Bond Act of 8 2007"; the "Green Acres, Water Supply and Floodplain Protection, 9 and Farmland and Historic Preservation Bond Act of 2009"; and the 10 "Preserve New Jersey Act."

11 Of the \$23,298,172 provided in section 1 of the bill for the 12 acquisition of fee simple titles and development easements to \$22,416,375 is from constitutionally dedicated 13 farmland: corporation business tax (CBT) revenues in the "Preserve New 14 15 Jersey Farmland Preservation Fund" established pursuant to the 16 "Preserve New Jersey Act"; \$599,712 is from the "2009 Farmland 17 Preservation Fund" established pursuant to the "Green Acres, Water Supply and Floodplain Protection, and Farmland and Historic 18 19 Preservation Bond Act of 2009"; \$141,233 is from the "2007 20 Farmland Preservation Fund" established pursuant to the "Green 21 Acres, Farmland, Blue Acres, and Historic Preservation Bond Act of 2007"; \$103,308 is from the "Garden State Farmland 22 23 Preservation Fund" established pursuant to the "Garden State 24 Preservation Trust Act"; and \$37,544 is from the "1995 Farmland 25 Preservation Fund," established pursuant to the "Green Acres, 26 Farmland and Historic Preservation, and Blue Acres Bond Act of 27 1995."

In addition, this bill appropriates \$2,253,000 from the "Preserve 28 29 New Jersey Farmland Preservation Fund" to the SADC for the 30 purpose of providing stewardship grants for activities, beyond 31 routine operation and maintenance, undertaken by landowners, or 32 farm operators as agents for landowners, to repair, restore, or improve lands preserved for farmland preservation purposes, 33 34 including soil and water conservation project activities and deer-35 fencing activities.

The appropriations in this bill for the acquisition of fee simple titles and development easements to farmland and for stewardship grants have been approved by the SADC and the Garden State Preservation Trust.

The bill also appropriates to the SADC such sums from any additional proceeds which may become available by the effective date of the bill due to the lease or conveyance of farmland previously acquired in fee simple by the SADC, for the purpose of providing for the cost of acquisition by the SADC of development easements and fee simple titles to farmland for farmland preservation purposes.

47 This bill also appropriates from the "Preserve New Jersey48 Farmland Preservation Fund" to the SADC: \$3,985,000 for

organizational, administrative, and other work and services,
 including salaries, equipment, materials, and services necessary to
 administer the applicable provisions of the "Preserve New Jersey
 Act"; \$250,000 for costs associated with administering the direct
 easement program; and \$100,000 for costs associated with the
 review of appraisals.
 The "Preserve New Jersey Act," P.L.2016, c.12 (C.13:8C-43 et

8 seq.), implements the constitutional dedication of CBT revenues 9 pursuant to Article VIII, Section II, paragraph 6 of the State 10 Constitution, approved by the voters of the State in November 2014, for open space, farmland, and historic preservation. The 11 "Preserve New Jersey Farmland Preservation Fund" was established 12 13 pursuant to section 8 of the "Preserve New Jersey Act." Of the 14 funding in this bill, \$29,004,375 is from these constitutionally dedicated CBT revenues. 15
