8	of P.L.2016, c.12 (C.13:8C-48) or any other law to the contrary, the
9	expenditure of funds pursuant to this section shall not require the
10	approval of the Joint Budget Oversight Committee, or its successor.

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31	STATEMENT
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33	This bill appropriates the sum of \$37.16 million to the
34	Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) to provide funding
35	for capital projects and park development on lands administered by
36	the DEP's Division of Parks and Forestry and Division of Fish and
37	Wildlife pursuant to the "Preserve New Jersey Act," P.L.2016, c.12
38	(C.13:8C-43 et seq.).
39	The funding in this bill is provided from constitutionally
40	dedicated corporation business tax (CBT) revenues pursuant to
41	Article VIII, Section II, paragraph 6 of the State Constitution,
42	approved by the voters of the State in November 2014. The
43	"Preserve New Jersey Act" implements the constitutional
44 45	dedication of CBT revenues for open space, farmland, and historic
45 46	preservation. The act provides that a certain amount of the portion
46 47	of dedicated CBT revenues allocated each year for the Green Acres
47	program is to be used for: the acquisition of lands for open space,

including Blue Acres projects, and development projects on State

lands administered by the DEP's Division of Fish and Wildlife and

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- 1 Division of Parks and Forestry; grants and loans to fund local
- 2 government open space acquisition and development projects; and
- 3 grants to nonprofit entities to acquire or develop lands for
- 4 recreation and conservation purposes. This bill appropriates funds
- 5 for capital and park development projects on State lands
- 6 administered by the DEP's Division of Fish and Wildlife and
- 7 Division of Parks and Forestry. The "Preserve New Jersey Green
- 8 Acres Fund" was established by section 6 of the "Preserve New
- 9 Jersey Act."
- The projects and appropriations listed in this bill have been
- 11 approved by the DEP and the Garden State Preservation Trust.
