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| 28 | This bill requires veterans' facilities operated by the Department |
| 29 | of Military and Veterans' Affairs (DMVA) to provide payroll-based |
| 30 | journal information to the New Jersey Long-Term Care |
| 31 | Ombudsman. |
| 32 | A payroll-based journal is an auditable and accessible database |
| 33 | of staffing records. DMVA veterans' facilities would be required to |
| 34 | provide an annual report to the Ombudsman on this journal. The |
| 35 | Ombudsman would establish and implement procedures for |
| 36 | receiving, processing, and responding to the reports. The reports |
| 37 | would be due on or before the last day of the State fiscal year. The |
| 38 | Ombudsman would be permitted to request additional reports. |
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
