Directs DHS to develop mobile software program for SNAP recipients; appropriates \$2 million.

AN ACT concerning a mobile software program for New Jersey
Supplemental Nutritional Assistance Program recipients

<sup>1</sup> [and], <sup>1</sup> supplementing Title 44 of the Revised Statutes <sup>1</sup>, and making an appropriation <sup>1</sup>.

**BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:

- 1. As used in this act:
- "Commissioner" means the Commissioner of Human Services.

"Electronic benefit transfer card or benefit card" means a benefit card utilized by a consumer to gain access to nutrition assistance program benefits.

"<sup>1</sup>[Mobile] Mobile-friendly<sup>1</sup> software <sup>1</sup>[program]<sup>1</sup>" means a computer program or <sup>1</sup>web-based<sup>1</sup> software application designed to be <sup>1</sup>[downloaded onto and]<sup>1</sup> used in conjunction with a mobile electronic communication device, as defined herein, and available through multiple software platforms.

"Mobile electronic communication device" means any mobile device capable of communication or other transmission of information and includes, but is not limited to, a cellular telephone, wireless tablet, or other device with Internet capability, or other wireless communication device.

"Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program" or "SNAP" means the supplemental nutrition assistance program, established pursuant to the federal "Food and Nutrition Act of 2008," <sup>1</sup>[Pub.L.88-525] as Pub.L.110-246<sup>1</sup> (7 U.S.C. s.2011 et seq.).

- 2. a. The Department of Human Services shall develop and maintain, or enter into or modify an agreement with a third party to develop and maintain<sup>1</sup>[, a mobile] mobile-friendly<sup>1</sup> software <sup>1</sup>[program]<sup>1</sup> for SNAP recipients. The <sup>1</sup>[mobile] mobile-friendly<sup>1</sup> software <sup>1</sup>[program]<sup>1</sup> shall include, but not be limited to, functionality that allows a user of the mobile software program who is recipient of SNAP benefits to:
- (1) view the user's SNAP case status and the current benefits the user receives;
- 38 (2) <sup>1</sup> [view the current balance on the user's electronic benefit transfer card;
  - (3)]<sup>1</sup> request an electronic benefit transfer card or a replacement card <sup>1</sup>[and track the card's expected time of arrival by mail;
- 42 (4) (3) upload and submit required documents for continued 43 participation in SNAP and track the current processing status of those 44 documents;

EXPLANATION – Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted in the law.

15	a. waivers from the federal government, which are necessary for
16	the approval and implementation of this act; and
17	b. grants through the SNAP Process and Technology
18	Improvement Grants program within the United States Department
19	of Agriculture to receive federal funding to implement the
20	provisions of this act.

22	4. The Commissioner of Human Services, pursuant to the
23	"Administrative Procedure Act," P.L.1968, c.410 (C.52:14B-1 et
24	seq.), shall promulgate rules and regulations <sup>1</sup> as may be necessary <sup>1</sup>
25	to effectuate the provisions of this act.

27	<sup>1</sup> 5. There is appropriated \$2,000,000 from the General Fund to
28	the Department of Human Services to fund the development and
29	maintenance of the mobile friendly software required pursuant to
30	P.L., c. (C. ) (pending before the Legislature as this bill).

32	<sup>1</sup> [5.] 6. This act shall take effect immediately.
