BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:

1. a. The Department of Agriculture, in consultation with the Department of Education, shall provide a 10-cent per meal supplement to the existing federal reimbursement to operators of the federal summer food service program ² and the Seamless Summer Option (SSO)².

12 b. The Department of Agriculture, in consultation with the 13 Department of Education, shall provide guidance and support to 14 school districts necessary to effectuate the purposes of this act.

- 15 c. The Department of Agriculture²[, in consultation with the Department of Education, **]**² shall prepare and issue an annual report 16 to the Governor and, pursuant to section 2 of P.L.1991, c.164 17 18 (C.52:14-19.1), to the Legislature on the annual cost of the summer food service program ²and the Seamless Summer Option (SSO)² 19 supplement to the State per month, and the number of additional 20 students, since the prior year, participating in the summer food 21 service program ²or the Seamless Summer Option (SSO)². 22
 - d. The Legislature shall annually appropriate such funds as are necessary to implement this act.
