4	BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
5	of New Jersey:

7	1. A minor between 16 and 18 years of age may work up to 50
8	hours in one week during the period beginning on the last day of a
9	minor's school year and ending on Labor Day, with written
10	permission from a parent or legal guardian.

12	2. This act shall take effect immediately and shall expire on
13	September 6 of 2021.

16	STATEMENT
17	
18	This bill would permit minors between 16 and 18 years of age to
19	work up to 50 hours in a week during the summer period beginning
20	the last day of the minor's school year and ending on Labor Day. A
21	parent or guardian's permission is required. This bill takes effect
22	immediately and expires on September 6 of 2021.
