1	AN ACT concerning the State use of federal education funding in
2	response to the COVID-19 pandemic.

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BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:

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The Department of Education shall ¹, in addition to the submission of any report concerning federal stimulus dollars that is required pursuant to federal law or any other State law, 1 submit an 10 annual report by December 31 of each year to the Governor, and to the Legislature pursuant to section 2 of P.L.1991, c.164 (C.52:14-19.1), 12 concerning the amount of grant funds received by the department and distributed to school districts pursuant to the federal "Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act," Pub.L.116-136, the 14 federal "Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental 16 Appropriations (CRRSA) Act, 2021" Pub.L. 116-260, the federal "American Rescue Plan (ARP) Act of 2021," Pub.L.117-2, or any other federal funding made available to states to address the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic. The department shall also report the 20 purposes for which grant funds were used by recipient school districts. The department shall provide a final report regarding the expenditure of federal grant funds received to address the impact of COVID-19 on public education no later than six months following the complete

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This act shall take effect immediately and shall expire upon submission of the final report pursuant to section 1 of this act.

exhaustion of such funds by recipient school districts.
