Designates August 31 of each year "Overdose Awareness Day" in New Jersey.

4	WHEREAS, <sup>1</sup> [Drug addiction] <u>Substance use disorder</u> <sup>1</sup> is a chronic
5	disease ${}^{1}$ [,] that acterized by ${}^{1}$ the problematic, the compulsive ${}^{1}$ , the or
6	<sup>1</sup> [difficult to control drug] <u>difficult-to-control</u> <sup>1</sup> use <sup>1</sup> <u>of drugs and</u>
7	<u>other substances</u> , <sup>1</sup> despite harmful consequences; and
8	WHEREAS, <sup>1</sup> [Drug addiction] <u>Substance use disorder, particularly</u>
9	when it involves opioid drugs, <sup>1</sup> is seen by both the $^{1}$ federal <sup>1</sup>
10	Centers for Disease Control $^{1}and$ Prevention $^{1}$ and the World Health
10	Organization as a fast-growing epidemic that can all too easily lead
12	to overdose and death; and
13	WHEREAS, In 2018, 67,367 individuals died from drug overdoses in
14	the United States; and
15	WHEREAS, In New Jersey alone, 2,900 people died from drug
16	overdoses in 2018; and
17	WHEREAS, Furthermore, for every drug overdose that results in death,
18	there are many more nonfatal overdoses, each taking an emotional
19	and economic toll on <sup>1</sup> [the individual] $individuals^1$ , their
20	<sup>1</sup> [family] <u>families</u> <sup>1</sup> , and the community at large; and
21	WHEREAS, <sup>1</sup> [Drug addiction] <u>A substance use disorder</u> <sup>1</sup> can fuel
22	feelings of shame, guilt, embarrassment, depression, and
23	hopelessness, causing individuals to resist seeking treatment and
24	support; and
25	WHEREAS, Overdose Awareness Day is a global event held on August
26	31 of each year that aims to raise awareness of drug overdoses,
27	reduce the stigma of a drug-related death, and <sup>1</sup> [to] <sup>1</sup> acknowledge
28	the grief felt by families and friends remembering those who
29	<sup>1</sup> [have died or had a permanent injury] <u>died or were permanently</u>
30	<u>injured</u> <sup>1</sup> as a result of a drug overdose; and
31	WHEREAS, To further the goals of Overdose Awareness Day, all flags
32	throughout the State should be flown at half-staff for the day's
33 24	duration; and WHEREAS Recognizing Overdese Awereness Day in New Jersey
34 25	WHEREAS, Recognizing Overdose Awareness Day in New Jersey
35 36	sends a strong message to former <sup>1</sup> [or] <u>and</u> <sup>1</sup> current substance users, namely, that they are valued, and that overdose death is

39	BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate and General Assembly of the

42	1. August 31 of each year shall be designated as "Overdose
43	Awareness Day" in New Jersey to raise awareness of overdose and
44	reduce the stigma of a drug-related death.
