1 AN ACT concerning membership in the New Jersey Council of County
2 Colleges and amending N.J.S.18A:64A-26, N.J.S.18A:64A-27 and
3 P.L.1989, c.141.

5 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
6 of New Jersey:

7

8 1. N.J.S.18A:64A-26 is amended to read as follows:

9 18A:64A-26. There is established a body corporate and politic,
10 with succession, to be known as the New Jersey Council of County
11 Colleges. The county colleges and the county college commissions
12 **[shall] may** be members of the council.

15 2. N.J.S.18A:64A-27 is amended to read as follows:

16 18A:64A-27. The council shall consist of the presidents and
17 chairmen of the boards of trustees of the **[several]** county community
18 colleges and of the county college commissions which choose to be
19 members. A trustee board chairman may designate another member
20 of the board as an alternate to attend and to vote at council meetings
21 in the chairman's absence. The Chancellor shall ex officio be an
22 additional member without vote.

23 Members shall serve without compensation but shall be entitled to
24 be reimbursed for all reasonable and necessary expenses.

27 3. Section 9 of P.L.1989, c.141 (C.18A:64A-28.5) is amended to
28 read as follows:

29 9. For the purposes of defraying the expenses of the council, the
30 county colleges and county college commissions which are members
31 of the council shall pay the necessary expenses incurred by the council
32 and shall appropriate annually such sums for dues as may be assessed

EXPLANATION - Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and intended to be omitted in the law.

Matter underlined thus is new matter.

1 by the council. The assessment shall be made only upon a two-thirds
2 vote of the membership present at the meeting after written notice of
3 the proposed vote shall be given to each participating county college
4 and county college commission at least 60 days before the council
5 meeting at which the vote will be taken. Dues shall be on a graduated
6 scale according to the size of the county college and county college
7 commission.

10 4. This act shall take effect immediately.

13 STATEMENT

14
15 This bill amends current law to provide that the membership of
16 county colleges and county college commissions in the New Jersey
17 Council of County Colleges shall be optional. Presently all county
18 colleges and county college commissions are required to be members
19 of the council.
