1 AN ACT concerning special registration plates and supplementing
2 chapter 3 of Title 39 of the Revised Statutes.

4 **BE IT ENACTED** *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
5 *of New Jersey:*

7 1. a. Upon application of a qualified member of the Eastern
8 Paralyzed Veterans Association, the director shall issue, for the motor
9 vehicle owned or leased by the member, distinctive plates of a design
10 and color approved by the director, in addition to the registration
11 number and other markings or identification prescribed by law. The
12 plates shall bear the words "Eastern Paralyzed Veterans" and depict
13 the Eastern Paralyzed Veterans Association emblem.

14 b. The special license plates authorized by this act may be issued
15 upon proof, satisfactory to the director, that the applicant is presently
16 a qualified member of the Eastern Paralyzed Veterans Association.
17 The director shall promulgate rules and regulations governing the use
18 and issuance of these plates. The fee for these plates shall be \$15 in
19 addition to the fees otherwise prescribed by law for the registration of
20 motor vehicles.

21 c. The surviving spouse of a former member of the Eastern
22 Paralyzed Veterans Association who is eligible to operate a motor
23 vehicle in this State under the provisions of R.S.39:3-10 may retain the
24 special license plates obtained by the deceased spouse pursuant to this
25 section for display on a motor vehicle registered to the surviving
26 spouse under the provisions of R.S.39:3-4.

28 2. This act shall take effect on the first day of the sixth month after
29 enactment.

STATEMENT

34 This bill authorizes the Division of Motor Vehicles in the
35 Department of Law and Public Safety to issue special license plates for

1 the vehicles of members of the Eastern Paralyzed Veterans Association
2 (EPVA). The license plates would display the EPVA emblem, which
3 signifies that the owner is a qualified member of the EPVA. The fee
4 for the special plates would be \$15, in addition to the other
5 registration fees required by law.

6 The surviving spouse of an EPVA member would be permitted to
7 retain the special license plates obtained by the deceased spouse, if the
8 surviving spouse is a licensed driver.
