1 AN ACT concerning certain charitable organizations and amending
2 P.L.1994, c.16.

4 **BE IT ENACTED** *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
5 *of New Jersey:*

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7 1. Section 9 of P.L.1994, c.16 (C.45:17A-26) is amended to read
8 as follows:

9 9. a. The registration requirements of this act shall not apply to
10 any religious corporation, trust, foundation, association or
11 organization incorporated under the provisions of Title 15 or 16 of the
12 Revised Statutes or Title 15A of the New Jersey Statutes or
13 established for religious purposes. Any agency or organization
14 incorporated or established for charitable purposes and engaged in
15 effectuating one or more charitable purposes, which is affiliated with,
16 operated by, or supervised or controlled by a corporation, trust,
17 foundation, association, or organization incorporated or established
18 for religious purposes, or any other religious agency or organization
19 shall also be exempt.

20 b. The registration requirements of this act shall not apply to any
21 educational institution, the curriculums of which in whole or in part
22 are registered or approved by the State Department of Education or
23 the [State Department of Higher Education] Commission On Higher
24 Education, either directly or by acceptance of accreditation by an
25 accredited body recognized by these departments; an educational
26 institution confining its solicitation of contributions to its student
27 body, alumni, faculty and trustees, and their families; or a library
28 registered by the State Department of Education, provided that the
29 annual financial report of that institution or library shall be filed with
30 the State Department of Education where it shall be open for public
31 inspection.

32 c. A charitable organization that meets all of the following
33 requirements shall be considered registered as required by this act:

34 (1) The charitable organization is a local unit of a parent

1 organization which is registered pursuant to this act;

2 (2) The parent organization has provided all information
3 concerning the local unit required by subsection e. of section 7 or
4 subsection c. of section 8 of this act;

5 (3) All solicitations made by the local unit are made by members of
6 the local unit or volunteers;

7 (4) The local unit does not employ a fund raising counsel or
8 independent paid fund raiser or utilize paid staff in preparation of
9 materials or records concerning or related to the solicitations; and

10 (5) (a) The local unit does not receive gross contributions in excess
11 of \$25,000 during the fiscal year; or

12 (b) The local unit is an organization that limits membership to
13 persons who are or formerly were employed as officers statutorily
14 authorized to enforce the criminal laws of this State.

15 d. Nothing in subsection c. of this section shall be construed to
16 require a parent organization to register any or all of its local units.

17 e. The registration requirements of this act shall not apply to any
18 charitable organization chartered by Little League Baseball,
19 Incorporated, or to any other charitable organization organized solely
20 for the purpose of promoting little league baseball.

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23 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

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STATEMENT

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28 This bill exempts charitable little league baseball organizations from
29 the registration requirements of the “Charitable Registration and
30 Investigation Act.”
