1 AN ACT concerning special license plates for municipal clerks and  
2 supplementing chapter 3 of Title 39 of the Revised Statutes.

3  
4 **BE IT ENACTED** *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*  
5 *of New Jersey:*

6  
7 1. a. Upon the application of the clerk of a municipality, the  
8 director shall issue special license plates for a motor vehicle owned or  
9 leased by that person. The plates shall bear the words "municipal  
10 clerk" in addition to the registration number and other markings and  
11 identification otherwise required by law.

12 b. The special license plates authorized by this section shall be  
13 issued upon the presentation of proof, satisfactory to the director, that  
14 the applicant is a municipal clerk. A municipal clerk who has been  
15 issued special license plates under this section and has served in that  
16 position for less than 10 years shall return the plates when he ceases  
17 to hold that position. A municipal clerk who has served in that  
18 position for 10 years or longer may retain the special license plates  
19 after leaving that position.

20 c. The fee for the special plates authorized by this section shall be  
21 \$25, in addition to the fees otherwise prescribed by law for the  
22 registration of motor vehicles.

23 d. The director may promulgate rules and regulations, pursuant to  
24 the "Administrative Procedure Act," P.L.1968, c.410 (C.52:14B-1 et  
25 seq.), governing the issuance and use of the special license plates  
26 authorized by this section.

28 2. This act shall take effect on the first day of the fourth month  
29 after enactment.

STATEMENT

34 This bill authorizes the Division of Motor Vehicles in the  
35 Department of Transportation to issue special license plates for the  
36 vehicles of municipal clerks. The plates would bear the words  
37 "municipal clerk," in addition to other markings and identification

1 required by law. The fee for these plates would be \$25 in addition to  
2 the fees otherwise prescribed by law. The bill would permit a  
3 municipal clerk who has served in that position 10 years or longer to  
4 retain the special plates after leaving the position.
