1 AN ACT concerning certification for local health officers to perform
2 lead evaluation and supplementing P.L.1993, c.288 (C.26:2Q-1 et
3 seq.).

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5 **BE IT ENACTED** *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
6 *of New Jersey:*

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8 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of P.L.1993, c.288 (C.26:2Q-1
9 et seq.) to the contrary, the requirement that a local health officer be
10 certified in order to perform lead evaluation pursuant to section 3 of
11 P.L.1993, c.288 (C.26:2Q-3) shall not take effect until one year after
12 the date that the Commissioner of Health certifies to the President of
13 the New Jersey Health Officers Association that training courses
14 developed, offered or accredited by the Department of Health and
15 required for certification pursuant to section 4 of P.L.1993, c.288
16 (C.26:2Q-4) are offered in every county in the State and are open for
17 enrollment by any local health officer wishing to apply for certification.

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19 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

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STATEMENT

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24 This bill amends P.L.1993, c.288 (C.26:2Q-1 et seq.) to provide
25 that the requirement for a local health officer to be certified in order
26 to perform lead evaluation pursuant to that law shall not take effect
27 until one year after the date that the Commissioner of Health certifies
28 to the President of the New Jersey Health Officers Association that
29 training courses developed, offered or accredited by the Department
30 of Health and required for certification pursuant to section 3 of
31 P.L.1993, c.288 (C.26:2Q-3) are offered in every county in the State
32 and are open for enrollment by any local health officer wishing to
33 apply for certification.

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3 Makes certification requirement for local health officers to perform

4 lead evaluation subject to availability of required training courses

5 Statewide.
