INTRODUCED JUNE 3, 1996

1 ANACT appropriating funds from the "Public Purpose Buildings and
2 Community-Based Facilities Construction Fund" to the Department
3 of Corrections to replace the heat distribution system at Bayside
4 State Prison.

6 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
7 of New Jersey:

9 1. There is appropriated to the Department of Corrections from the
10 "Public Purpose Buildings and Community-Based Facilities
11 Construction Fund" created pursuant to the "Public Purpose Buildings
12 and Community-Based Facilities Construction Bond Act of 1989,"
13 P.L.1989, c.184, the sum of \$5,000,000 for the following project:

17 Bayside State Prison..... \$5,000,000
18 Special Purpose:
19 Replace Heat Distribution System.....(\$5,000,000)
20 Total Appropriation..... \$5,000,000

22 2. There is also appropriated from the "Public Purpose Buildings
23 and Community-Based Facilities Construction Fund," such items as
24 may be necessary to meet any expense incurred by the issuing officials
25 under P.L.1989, c.184 for advertising, engraving, printing, clerical,
26 legal or other services necessary to carry out the duties imposed upon
27 them by the provisions of that act.

29 3. In order to provide flexibility in administering the provisions of
30 this act, the Commissioner of the Department of Corrections may
31 apply to the Director of the Division of Budget and Accounting in the
32 Department of the Treasury for permission to transfer a part of any
33 item to any other item within the respective department accounts in the
34 "Public Purpose Buildings and Community-Based Facilities
35 Construction Fund" account. The transfers shall be made in a manner
36 consistent with section 29 of P.L.1989, c.184.

1       4. This act shall take effect immediately.

STATEMENT

6       This bill would appropriate \$5,000,000 to the Department of  
7       Corrections from the "Public Purpose Buildings and Community Based  
8       Facilities Construction Fund" for the replacement of the heat  
9       distribution system at the Bayside State Prison. The present system is  
10      the original heat distribution system installed as part of the original  
11      construction of the facility in 1969 which due to age and subsurface  
12      conditions in that area has deteriorated.
