AN ACT concerning the Pension and Health Benefits Review 1 2 Commission and amending P.L.1991, c.382. 3 4 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State 5 of New Jersey: 6 7 1. Section 1 of P.L.1991, c.382 (C.52:9HH-1) is amended to read 8 as follows: 9 1. There is hereby established a Pension and Health Benefits 10 Review Commission. The commission shall consist of [10] 12 11 members: the State Treasurer and three other members of the 12 Executive Branch, who shall be designated by the Governor and who 13 shall serve at the Governor's pleasure; two public members to be 14 appointed by the President of the Senate, no more than one of whom shall be of the same political party; two public members to be 15 16 appointed by the Speaker of the General Assembly, no more than one of whom shall be of the same political party; [and] two public 17 members, no more than one of whom shall be of the same political 18 19 party, to be appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of 20 the Senate; and two public employee members who are in the career service to be appointed by the Governor, upon the recommendation of 21 22 the New Jersey State AFL-CIO, and with the advice and consent of 23 the Senate. 24 Public members appointed by the Governor shall serve for a term 25 of four years and until their respective successors are appointed and qualified, except that of the public members first appointed, one shall 26 serve for a term of two years and one shall serve for a term of four 27 28 years. Public employee members appointed by the Governor shall 29 serve for a term of four years and until their respective successors are 30 appointed and qualified, except that of the public employee members 31 first appointed, one shall serve for a term of two years and one shall 32 serve for a term of four years. Public members appointed by the 33 President of the Senate or Speaker of the General Assembly shall serve 34 during the two-year legislative term in which the appointment is made

1 and until their respective successors are appointed and qualified. Any 2 vacancy in the membership of the commission shall be filled for the balance of the unexpired term in the same manner as the original 3 4 appointment was made. A chairman of the commission shall be designated by the Governor 5 from among its public members and shall serve at the pleasure of the 6 7 Governor. 8 Members of the commission shall serve without compensation but shall be entitled to reimbursement for expenses actually incurred in the 9 10 performance of their duties. This act shall take effect immediately. 14 15 16 **STATEMENT** 17 This bill expands the Pension and Health Benefits Review 18 Commission from 10 to 12 members by adding two public employee 19 members who are in the career service of the civil service. These 20 21 members shall be appointed by the Governor, upon the recommendation of the New Jersey State AFL-CIO, and with the 22 23 advice and consent of the Senate. 24 25 26 27 Adds two career service public employee members to the Pension and 28 Health Benefits Review Commission. 29
