1 AN ACT concerning the application fee for certain examinations and
2 amending P.L.1992, c.197.

4 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
5 of New Jersey:

7 1. Section 1 of P.L.1992, c.197 (C.11A:4-1.1) is amended to read
8 as follows:

9 1. a. The Commissioner of the Department of Personnel shall
10 establish a \$5 fee for each application for an open competitive or
11 promotional examination. Persons receiving public assistance benefits
12 pursuant to P.L.1947, c.156 (C.44:8-107 et seq.), P.L.1959, c.86
13 (C.44:10-1 et seq.), or P.L.1973, c.256 (C.44:7-85 et seq.) shall not
14 be required to pay this fee if they apply for an open competitive
15 examination. Receipts derived from application fees ¹established by
16 this subsection¹ shall be appropriated to the department.

17 b. In addition to the fee established in subsection a. of this section,
18 the commissioner shall establish a \$5 fee for each application for an
19 open competitive or promotional examination for a position in State
20 service. Persons receiving public assistance benefits pursuant to
21 P.L.1947, c.156 (C.44:8-107 et seq.), P.L.1959, c.86 (C.44:10-1 et
22 seq.), or P.L.1973, c.256 (C.44:7-85 et seq.) shall not be required to
23 pay this fee if they apply for an open competitive examination.
24 Receipts derived from the application fee established pursuant to this
25 subsection shall be appropriated annually to the department for the
26 costs of the displaced workers pool program. This fee shall not be
27 assessed and collected unless the commissioner implements a
28 displaced workers pool program. If the displaced workers pool
29 program is terminated at any time by the commissioner, the assessment
30 and collection of this additional fee shall also be terminated.
